BIOGRAPHY for DANIEL A. CLEARFIELD, DO, MS, FAOASM

Doctor Daniel Clearfield is a Board-Certified physician in Primary Care Sports Medicine as well as Family Medicine & Osteopathic Manipulative Medicine (OMM). He is a 2nd generation Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine (D.O.) who grew up in Arlington, Texas. He graduated from James Martin High School and was an all-state wrestler and Captain of the wrestling team. He then attended the University of Texas at Austin earning a Bachelor of Science in Kinesiology, graduating Cum Laude with Honors. He then attended the University of North Texas Health Science Center (UNTHSC) where he earned his D.O. degree from the Texas College of Osteopathic Medicine (TCOM) as well as his Master of Science in Clinical Research and Education in OMM from the Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences. He completed an Osteopathic Family Medicine Residency at Doctors Hospital in Columbus, Ohio where he served as Chief Resident. He completed a Pre-Doctoral Fellowship in OMM at TCOM and a Primary Care Sports Medicine Fellowship with Overlook Hospital in Summit, New Jersey.

Dr. Clearfield started the company *Motion is Medicine Sports Medicine* as a Primary Care Sports Medicine physician and Concussion specialist in 2019. He has experience in treating all varieties of athletic, overuse, and degenerative injuries in all ages of patients and athletes. He is an Adjunct Professor at UNTHSC-TCOM where he previously served as an Assistant Professor of Orthopedic Surgery and as the Program Director for the UNTHSC-TCOM Primary Care Sports Medicine Fellowship. In addition, he serves as teaching faculty for the Department of OMM at TCOM, the Medical Cities Family Medicine Residency and the Weatherford Medical Center Internal Medicine Residency. He has extensive training in diagnostic musculoskeletal/sports ultrasound (MSK-US) and ultrasound-guided injections, regenerative injection therapies (including stem cell, platelet-rich plasma (PRP), and prolotherapy), percutaneous needle tenotomy (PNT), nerve blocks and hydrodissection, orthotic construction, casting/splinting and fracture management, joint and soft tissue injections and aspirations, concussion management utilizing ImPACT, XLNT Brain and SCAT testing modalities, ECG interpretation in athletes, osteopathic manipulative treatment (OMT), auricular hematoma management, toenail and fingernail removal, office spirometry,

and other procedures germane to outpatient family and sports medicine.
